PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

Fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust or fumes. Wear protective clothing, protective eyewear, and respiratory protection listed under the "Personal Protective Equipment" section of the "Supplemental Labeling Fulex Nicotine Fumigator" sheet. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposing of wastes.

User Safety Recommendations

Users should:

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

If in eyes	- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. - Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing eye. - Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
