

Using the Interactive MSU Pesticide Education Survey Modules

You must use Turning Point Technologies Audience Response Devices to use these surveys. You can borrow these devices either from the MSU Pesticide Education Program (1 set of 46 transmitters) or MSU Extension (contact IT at Culbertson Hall, 994-5638).

1. Step 1 → Download the survey you are interested in.

2. Step #2 → Load the Turning Point Technologies drivers on your computer (this is a CD that will be sent to you).
3. Step #3 → Open 'Turning Point' (should be available on your desktop once installed), and open the PEP survey you downloaded in step #1.
4. Step #4 → Remember to set the total # of receivers you will be using. Go to tools then settings. Select 'response devices', then change 'expected devices' to the # of transmitters you plan on using.
5. Step #5 → Either leave entire survey in tact or load only the specific questions you are interested in (recommending leaving all survey questions in tact). Survey questions you are interested in may be interlaced in another existing PowerPoint presentation or left as a separate program. Do not change any of the survey questions as this will render the question incompatible with other regional surveys. Save.
6. Step #5 → At event, distribute transmitters and open your surveys using only 'Turning Point'. Place receiver in your USB port. Conduct survey.
7. Step #6 → When presentation is over select 'Save Session'. Rename this session (Example: Safety Meagher County Program 2009112) and save it in a location you can easily find.
8. Step #7 Send as an attachment to ctharp@montana.edu.

All surveys will be included in regional reports and will be used in future educational programs.
